Finally, meet the 14 Danish Slow Food Farms. Learn more about the idea behind the Slow Food Farms network in a quick video from Slow Food International.







14 Slow Food Farms in Denmark

A Slow Food Farm is one that regenerates the soil, supports the people involved, and nurtures all the living beings that make our food possible. Slow Food describes this approach as agro-ecological. Through this network, Slow Food aims to connect these farms, increase their visibility, and strengthen the movement for more sustainable and democratic food systems.

Worldwide, there are now 400 Slow Food Farms across 63 countries - and the network continues to grow. Meet the first 14 in Denmark
