

Web Assistant for Communication About Good, Clean and Fair Food

Do you have experience with web development? Do you know Wordpress – and interest in both front end design and backend development? Can you imagine a world where food is good and clean – and fair for all? Come join us in Slow Food, a global grass root movement: We want to change the food system.



In Slow Food Denmark, we are looking for a technical web assistant to help update and improve our website. We are starting a communication group with SoMe activists and you as a web assistant, so we can attract more participants to our events - and hopefully also more members all over Denmark. We are also starting up a youth group again - a "Slow Food Youth Network".

In the transition from the previous volunteer webmaster, knowledge has been lost...

Your tasks will be:

- to update content about activities in collaboration with other active volunteers
- problem solving: Updating the navigation menus
- problem solving: Displaying the Instagram feed on the front page of www.slowfood.dk
- to look into and implement the Wordpress API updates
- to ensure that the website complies with cookie regulations
- knowledge sharing with other members about beautiful layout on pages using Divi Builder
- integration of newsletter subscription (MailerLite)

We expect that you can spend 1-2 hours a week and attend a monthly meeting. You are welcome at our events, 6-10 per year, primarily in the Copenhagen area. The work is voluntary, unpaid, and both meaningful and a great opportunity to broaden your skills.

About you:

We expect you to have experience using Wordpress to update and edit existing websites. Maybe you also know the Divi Builder? Technical knowledge and interest for web development is an advantage, and you will solve both front end and backend tasks. Maybe you even follow trends in the integration between web and social media? Text is contributed by all active participants, so you communicate and collaborate preferably in both Danish and English.

We offer:

You will have great influence and flexibility in your independent work, which takes place from your own computer (and phone).

You will gain insight into and practical experience with web development and web integration with other communication platforms (Facebook, Instagram, newsletter, ticket system). The scope of the role grows with your skills, interests and long-term commitment. If we have the time and resources, we can dream together about better interaction between the web and social media, about newsletters, SEO, traffic analytics, language versions – and this is where you can bring your skills as a project manager into play.

You will be a part of a communication group with both young and experienced members - in a local community of a global NGO. Through Slow Food's core of committed and long lasting members, you get access to knowledge and network about everything going on in our food systems. Well, and our meetings and events always end with sharing a good meal together!
